- 1. Call meeting to order; Chair, Lawrence Klippenstein.

- 5. Lawrence had attended the Rosenfeld book launch. Approximately 150 were attendance at the event and the book is going into a second printing.

The next issue is planned for March.
- 7. EastMenn will be erecting a cairn to commemorate Jacob Y.Schantz approximately where the Immigration sheds were set up near Niverville. It will be unveiled summer of 2019.
- 8. EastMenn is considering setting up tours. Lawrence has suggested that they might set aside a 6 square mile Mennonite park to get the Mennonite story complete. This would be in addition to the MHV and create an

- awareness beyond Highway #12. He also wants the museum to acknowledge that 6 of the MHV historical buildings are from the West Reserve.
- 9. Albert Falk reported on the Atlas committee consisting of Pam Klassen Dueck, Sean Goerzen, Andrew Brown, Lawrence Klippenstein, Dave Harms as consultant, Peter Priess as editor, and Albert Falk as chair. Albert presented a roster of tasks that Pam had prepared including, but not limited to determining the scope, footnotes, sources; get funding advice and sources; list of proposals for funding; and software considerations. Jake Rempel will be a helpful resource and the late Peter E. Hildebrand's book collection may available to the committee. This may be a 3-5 year project.
